

Calderfields Golf & Country Club Data Policy Privacy Policy Notice

We are a "data controller". This means that we are responsible for deciding how we hold and use personal information about you. We are required by law to inform you about the information which we hold to enable you to understand the purposes for which it is used.

This Notice explains the types of personal information about you which we hold and how we use it, and how we use any personal information which we collect about you when you use this website.

1. What information do we collect about you?

When you contact us with a view to engaging our services, you are required to complete a form which includes details of your name, address, other contact details, age and occupation.

2. How we use the information about you

We use the information which you provide in order to manage your golf membership and communication with us here at Calderfields. We may also use the information to email you about our products and services which we think may be of interest to you.

We will not sell or share your information for marketing purposes with any other company or third party.

3. Legal basis for using information

We will only use the personal information about you which we hold to the extent that the law allows us to do so. The legal basis on which we will normally use the information is as follows:

- 1. a) where we need to perform our contract with you for the provision of the services that you have requested; or
- 2. b) where we need to comply with a legal obligation; or
- 3. c) where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party), provided that your interests and rights do not override our interests.

The circumstances in which we may use personal information to pursue legitimate interests include some or all of the following:

- Where the processing enables us to enhance, modify, personalise or otherwise improve our services/communications for the benefit of our customers.
- To identify and prevent fraud.
- To enhance the security of our network and information systems.
- To better understand how people interact with our website.
- To provide communications which we think will be of interest to you.
- To determine the effectiveness of promotional campaigns and advertising.

4. Marketing and Communication

From the outset of our instruction, you are invited to say whether you would like to receive from us information about products or services which may be of interest to you. If you consent to receive such marketing information, you may opt out at a later date if you change your mind. You have the right at any time to tell us to stop sending such information to you. If you wish to do this, please notify us by sending an email to us or write to us, using the email or postal addresses set out at paragraph 12 below.

5. Access to your information and correction

You have the right to request a copy of the information which we hold about you. If you would like a copy of some or all of your personal information, please email us or write to us using the email or postal addresses specified in paragraph 12 below.

We want to make sure that your personal information is accurate and up to date. You may ask us to correct or remove any information which you think is inaccurate.

6. Security

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal information from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed.

We will deal promptly with any suspected breach of security and will notify you and the Information Commissioner's Office of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

7. For how long is personal information retained?

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

8. Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and visitor behaviour information. This information is used to track visitor use of the website and to compile statistical reports on user activity.
