- We had a big outgoing this year of £7177.50, when you hear this you may think this is a massive amount going out but when you look at what this money goes on you will understand.
- Without listing everything, we have paid for Handicap Master, The Alliance and 17-24 team entries and league competitions, trophy engraving, winner boards updating. We had a lot more members claiming their vouchers this year and some vouchers from last year claimed also.
