
More than just a Golf Club


On Arrival

Please register at our Professional Shop, which is located within the Staffordshire Performance Golf Centre, it is next to the first tee and with easy access through the Golfer's Tunnel or via the Clubhouse reception area.

Once you have registered one of our golf team will provide you with your scorecard and answer any questions you may have about the course.

If you are a golf break guest, you must also visit our Clubhouse reception area to book into your cabin.

Indoor Golf Simulator Facility

Book a lesson with one of our PGA Professionals or hire out this facility to play 18 holes of golf around your favorite course in a warm and dry environment.

Practice Range

Our Practice Range is available to allow you to warm up prior to going out on the course. A basket of range balls is available from our Pro Shop.

Please note that any club above a 7 iron are NOT allowed to be used on this facility.

We also have a couple of Practice Nets will are readily available for you to use.



Buggies

We have a brand-new fleet of electric buggies that are fitted with the latest Pace Technology which will enable you to get accurate GPS distances and detailed course information on their high-definition screens.

We advise you to pre-book your buggies in advance of your round, to avoid any disappointment on the day.

Please pick up your buggy key from our Pro shop.

Practice Areas

We have two Practice Areas available for you to use.

These are: chipping Area on the left of the main path towards the first tee and the putting area is on the right.


Visitors' Locker Room

These are located in the Clubhouse with their entrance opposite the reception desk. Please use these facilities to get changed/ready prior to and after your round of golf.

Please do not get changed in the Car Park.



On the Course



Please arrive at the first tee at least Ten (10) minutes before your tee time.

The Course

This 18-hole, Par 72 course can prove to be a challenge for all level of golfers with three Par 5 and three Par 3 holes. It has many feature holes but the signature 8th hole which is just 317 yds requires a straight drive to ensure you can accurately get over the lake on to the inviting green.

Pace of Play

A standard four ball round of golf should take 4 hours and 15 minutes. Please be aware of your position on the course and always keep up with the group in front, not just ahead of the group behind.

Please play without delay and allow faster groups to play through.

In support of the R&A proposal to help speed up play we have adopted the 'Ready Golf' philosophy which all golfers playing at Calderfields G&CC are required to uphold.

The pace of play is monitored and groups playing slow will be asked to "speed up".

Dress Code

Although our dress code is fairly relaxed, we do require a minimum standard of attire, therefore, we ask all visitors to wear clothing that is smart recognised golf attire. (if in doubt, simply refer to what Professionals wear on their tours). This means that we expect all golfers to wear shirts which have collars and sleeves (Mock neck shirts are acceptable), smart trousers or tailored shorts. If caps are worn, they must be worn with the peak at the front. Caps are not allowed in the clubhouse.

Items of clothing which are not permitted on the course include: Football shirts, Tee Shirts, Jeans, Jogging or tracksuit bottoms, Beach or Sports type shorts, Trainers or Sandals.

Course Etiquette

We expect all our golfers to always behave in a polite as well as courteous manner and to respect the course by repairing pitch marks, replacing divots and raking bunkers.

Greens staff should be always given priority.

Trolleys

Must not be taken on to the teeing areas, between the greenside bunkers and on to the greens.

Any specific further restrictions will be noted on the board outside our pro shop.

Mobile Phones

The making and receiving of calls on the course are not permitted. Phones may be used on the course in emergency situations only.

Suspension of Play Due to a Dangerous Situation:

In the event of a dangerous situation for example a lightning storm, play will be suspended immediately. This is signalled by the sounding of the hooter/klaxon. In this event, players must vacate the course immediately.

Score Card

Play should be from the yellow tees for men and from the red tees for ladies.

The 150 yds marker is measured from the front of the greens.

Please check the white board outside the Pro shop for any additional local rules. The slope rating chart is displayed on the noticeboard adjacent to the first tee. Flag positions on the Green RED = Front YELLOW = Middle WHITE = Back

The Clubhouse

Our clubhouse with its raised patio area is a great place to sit and relax after your round of golf. With magnificent panoramic views across the tree ladened parkland course with our fishing lake in the distance.

Within the Club House you will find the Golfer's lounge which has been recently rebranded "Alan's Sports Lounge" so called as a tribute to one of our Directors who sadly died in 2022. In here are a couple of large televisions with live Sky Sports, a pool table and a dart board.

Located next to this lounge is the Golfer's Conservatory where you can sit back and enjoy a sandwich whilst watching other golfers warming up and preparing to tee off.

The provision of high-quality food and refreshments is an integral part of the clubhouse and for that reason we use locally sources suppliers, the team of expert chefs always prepare and cook the food on site.

Whether you want a breakfast, light snack, or a three-course meal we have got it covered with our regular menu along with our "daily specials" menu.

Food is available every day from 08:00 and closing times do vary depending upon demand.

Please note our bar and restaurant areas are completely cashless.



The Log Cabins

Each of our cabin sits next to the 18th hole fairway with some great views over the parkland golf course. They are all south facing so you are met in the morning with the rising sun.

Each cabin comes with Freeview television, twins or double bed, tea/coffee making facilities, wardrobe, desk and spacious en-suite all tastefully finished with a marble and granite interior.

Located just 100 yards from our free car park and with no steps to negotiate, the cabins lend themselves perfectly to any disabled or elderly guests.

Check in is from 3:00 pm and please check out by 11:00 am, however, you are welcome to ask for an early check in or late check out.

If you arrive and our reception desk is closed, then one of the team at the bar will quickly process your check in.



The Fishing Lake

The lake accommodates just eight pegs which are all sheltered from straying golf balls, meaning fishermen can enjoy a day of uninterrupted contentment.

The fishing lake is open to the public and you must register at our pro shop were you will receive a warm welcome before signing a waiver and learning any specific and safety instructions before being issued a day ticket.

The lake is open from dusk till dawn and any overnight fishing is strictly prohibited as too are BBQs and campfires.

The lake plays host to a variety of fish including Common carp, Mirror carp, Roach, Rudd, Perch and Tench.

We receive regular compliments about the health of our fish, and it is not uncommon to see weights of 15lbs and over!



Walsall

Walsall Leather Museum

This is a great attraction housed in a restored Victorian factory building. It offers an interesting insight into the story of Walsall's famous leatherworking trade. There are regular guided tours and demonstrations of leather crafts.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 1.75 miles

Walsall Arboretum

This parkland retreat very close to Walsall town centre opened in 1874. It spans 170 acres and includes Hatherton Lake, the country park and the extension. The park includes gardens, green spaces, play areas, visitor's centre and sports facilities.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 2.0 miles

The new Art Gallery

This is a modern and contemporary art gallery in the town centre. It houses many sculptures and paintings by modern masters including Jacob Epstein, Vincent van Gogh, Claude Monet, Turner, Corot, Renoir and Constable.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 2.1 miles

Lichfield

Lichfield Cathedral

This is a treasured landmark in the heart of the city that prides itself in offering a warm welcome to all our visitors. There is plenty to see with over 1300 years of history in the only medieval three spired Cathedral in the UK

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 10.5 miles

National Memorial Arboretum

This is is the UK's year-round centre of Remembrance. The expansive 150acre site which featuring over 330 thought-provoking memorials, nestled amongst lush and maturing woodland. Military and Civilian associations are represented alongside tributes for individuals.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 17.0 miles

Dudley

The Black Country Living Museum

This great museum tells the story of the creation of the world's first industrial landscape. Over fifty authentic shops, houses and workshops have been carefully reconstructed to preserve the character of the region when its manufacturers bought worldwide fame to Black Country Towns. Take a trip on the tram to explore the canal-side village, where you can meet and chat to the costumed characters.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 10.3 miles

Dudley Zoo and Castle

This is home to more than 1300 animals, and has nigh on 200 species, including some of the rarest creatures on Earth. Hundreds of exotic and endangered animals inhabit an ancient, wooded hillside with Dudley Castle on its crown.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 11.0 miles

Cannock

McArthur Glen Designer Outlet West Midlands

The outlet consists of a range of designer brand stores offering clothing, beauty, homeware, gifts, and accessories at discounted prices. Currently there are approximately 63 stores and 8 restaurants listed as being on site.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 9.5 miles

Chasewater County Park

This park boasts a beautiful reservoir and acres of wet lowland heathland that is home to deer, newts and many bird species. There is a fully working railway with vintage steam and diesel trains to enjoy. All the family can enjoy bird watching, walking and cycling across the easy terrain. Along with the chance to relax in the South Shore Café

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 7.9 miles



Tamworth

Drayton Manor Park

Allow plenty of time to enjoy all the thrills and spills of the theme park. It is the home of Thomas Land, but it also family favourites such as, The Carousel or The Bounty Pirate Ship. You could take a flight on Maelstrom and Air Race, feel the full throttle of Shockwave their stand-up roller coaster. The main park season which runs between March and October.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 13.0 miles

Birmingham

National Sea Life Centre

This is an aquarium with over 60 displays of freshwater and marine life in Brindleyplace. Its ocean tank has a capacity of 1,000,000 litres of water and houses giant green sea turtles, blacktip reef sharks and tropical reef fish, with the only fully transparent 360-degree underwater tunnel in the United Kingdom.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 13.5 miles

National Motorcycle Museum

The National Motorcycle Museum is recognised as the finest and largest British motorcycle museum in the world and originally opened its doors in October 1984 with a collection of 350 motorcycles on display. The collection now boasts some 1000 plus machines, fully restored to the manufacturer's original specifications.

Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 20.0 miles

This is an industry hub, home to more than 100 specialist retailers, diamond dealers, and workshops which produce 40% of all the jewellery made in the UK The Museum of the Jewellery Quarter, is a preserved 1980s factory of Smith & Pepper jewellery firm. Distance from Calderfields Golf and Country Club = 10.5 miles
