Matters Arising

Matters still outstanding; -

Fairway mats – due to a 11% negative response from the survey the fairway mats will not be brought in as a compulsory requirement over the winter period.

The committee discussed this and felt that we could introduce it for Texas Scramble competitions over the winter to get members used to and to see the benefits of mats, thereby look to introduce gradually with other comps. Team comps would only need 1 mat between a group and thereby make it easier to monitor, club to obtain quotes for mats.
